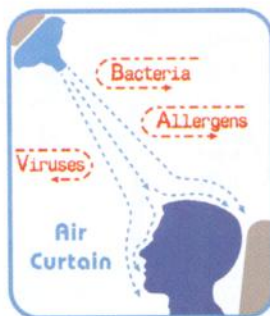


PLANE CLEAN AIR

**ZADRO NANO UV DISINFECTION LIGHTSCANNER**

Ever wanted to carry around a magic wand that zaps germs? Well, you'll come close with the Zadro Nano. It sounds like science fiction: Open up the cell-phone-sized device, scan the UV light over the germ-infested surface for 10 seconds, and you've instantly killed all kinds of nasty microorganisms. Zadro claims the scanner will work on the biggest offenders, such as the airplane tray table, bathroom surfaces and hotel bedding. It comes with two AAA batteries and has a 10-second timer switch for safe UV usage. **\$80**

Heightened airport safety introduces another fear for the germophobe: All the excess baggage your socks pick up while waiting to pass through the metal detector with your shoes off. Fortunately, there are FeetWraps, disposable slip-ons that keep the grime off your feet after you're done dragging them through security. PlaneWrap also makes several other disposable travel items, including a SeatWrap for the plane seat and a RestWrap for the headrest. **\$9.95 for a 10-pair pack of FeetWrap.**
